

#### **MEETING AGENDA:**

- 1. Call to Order: 7:04pm
- 2. Financial updates by Char: current balance \$7990.70
- a. Expenses since last meeting: Longhorn Lawns, 2 treatments totaling \$454.66, Mulching/Food Truck flyers \$37.02
- b. New member payments: 63 new member payments, total, thank you, all!
- 3. Non-recurring projects/events: at front entrance need to replace dead plants due to Feb. winter storm. Plan is to clean up first. Look at low maintenance plants & also planting wildflower seeds where weeds are currently growing in the back. Terri Robson is looking into best options.
- 4. Recurring events:
- a. Food Truck vendor was pleased with turnout & would like to come back. Residents had favorable comments regarding the food.
- b. Mulch Day great turnout, thank you, all! Job took less than an hour to finish.

The Silk Oak Neighborhood Park existing play equipment and play surface on the west side of the park is nearing its useful life and is scheduled to be replaced with new play equipment for a range of ages and new accessible safety surface.

#### **Anticipated Schedule**

- August to November 2020: Playground Design and Community Feedback
- November to December 2020: Final Design and Bidding
- January to April 2021: New Playground Installation
- May 2021: Playground Opening

Project delayed but a contractor is in place.
Probably end of summer



## Neighborhood Security

We are all concerned about keeping our neighborhood safe and crime free. We have the benefit of having only one entrance to the community which eliminates a quick getaway for those that want to perpetrate crimes. This is one of the selling points of our location and neighborhood but we still have to stay vigilant.

Recently one of our neighbors had their catalytic converter stolen off their car in the middle of the night. The thieves boldly used a portable grinder and cut it off and casually left.

We have individual home spotlights and cameras and camera doorbells throughout the neighborhood however, this did not deter the criminals.

The board is considering installing warning signs about community watch and monitoring. If you see these signs go up, please know that they are a deterrent and we do not have an organized crime watch or community security cameras at this time. Only cameras that are individually managed by you on your own property.

If you hear or see anything that looks suspicious, let's be sure to call it out and inform our neighbors or police.
