

# Water Department Special Assessment is being lifted November 6, 2021

The Cherry Creek on Brodie area was annexed in 1997. Properties within the former Southland Oaks MUD area have had a monthly assessment / surcharge to offset MUD debt that the City absorbed at the time the area was annexed and the MUD dissolved. According to the Austin Water department, there are no plans to extend the date past November 6, 2021. Everyone should see \$25 off their monthly water charges starting in November or December.
