

## Dues or not to Dues, that is the question?

Editorial by Terri Robson – dues paying member of CCOBNA

I have been in the neighborhood for almost 3 years and attended almost every board meeting. One struggle we continue to have as a community is collecting the Neighborhood Association Dues, \$60 per year from each household.

I heard a remark from 2 people recently that said they were exempt from paying dues, they were "grandfathered in". This confused me because our neighborhood association is voluntary, we are ALL exempt and ALL grandfathered in.

When the builders of Cherry Creek on Brodie completed all 248 homes they walked away from the neighborhood. They handed over the management of the community property to the Neighborhood Association (NA). We have community property that belongs to 248 homes in the name of the Cherry Creek on Brodie Neighborhood Association.

That property at the front of our neighborhood is our calling card, our presentation to Austin and a reflection of the quality of our neighborhood. It has brick monuments, trees, grass, lights, flowers and a watering system that cost money to maintain. Who should pay for that when we are all exempt and grandfathered in?

The association averages 70-80 dues paying homes each year... **mostly the same 70-80 homes paying every year!** 

My question is to the other approximately 170 "exempt and grandfathered" homes who choose not to pay, "Who should bear the cost of the community maintenance if you are not participating"?

### Water Department Special Assessment lifted November 6, 2021

<u>**Reminder**</u> for those who missed it or are new to CCOB, the area was annexed in 1997. Properties within the former Southland Oaks MUD area have had a monthly assessment / surcharge to offset MUD debt that the City absorbed at the time the area was annexed and the MUD dissolved. According to the Austin Water department, there are no plans to extend the date past November 6, 2021. Everyone should see \$25 off their monthly water charges starting in November or December.
