



Silk Oak Park updates

Canopy

2 new park benches were installed by the water fountain. That completes the update to the equipment however, a canopy or shade was requested and we are still on the list to have that done, confirmed with Charles Marbry of Austin Parks. I am not sure what the cover will be like but he confirms that it is in the budget and still on the list for fall.

Bridge

A sidewalk connection between Cherry Creek on Brodie and the Tanglewood subdivision on the other side of the back park has been discussed for a while and I have brought up again.

Apparently there is an issue that if the sidewalk connects, it will eliminate a school bus that picks up Cherry Creek kids because they would then have a shorter route to school.

The parks can make a bridge, but this will impact other City of Austin departments which makes it more complicated than us keeping our feet dry when we go across the muddy creek.

- 2. Financial Updates by Char & Carla
 - a. Expenses since last meeting: 2 Longhorn Lawns @ \$227.33 each, printing \$21.24, \$1001.29 tree trimming at front entrance, \$120 face painter
 - b. New member payments 2 which brings memberships up to around 85 houses and we need to reconcile to get an accurate count.
- 3. Non-recurring Projects/Events
 - a. Will evaluate in spring if we need Crepe Myrtle trimming
 - b. Light was broken at front entrance. Char bought 2 @ \$38 total.
- 4. Recurring Events
 - a. Fall Festival big success & \$145 from the "split the pot" will go toward our next event. We would strongly encourage more residents volunteering to help with setup/tear down at all events. A big thank you to Tammy Davison for doing everything, arrange the event, setup, tear down, etc....and to Patrick & Meghan Fortson who generously supply their electricity for our events at the back park.

- 5. Neighborhood Updates
 - a. MUD Fees should be removed. If they are on December bills we will contact the City in January.
 - b. Playground at back park. The City has said we will get shade structures put up within the next couple of months.

We need a bridge/sidewalk crossing back there but there is an ongoing issue pertaining to losing a bus route in Cherry Creek to Cowan if we do that so that would need to be resolved, first.

Water Department Special Assessment lifted November 6, 2021

<u>**Reminder**</u> for those who missed it or are new to CCOB, the area was annexed in 1997. Properties within the former Southland Oaks MUD area have had a monthly assessment / surcharge to offset MUD debt that the City absorbed at the time the area was annexed and the MUD dissolved. According to the Austin Water department, there are no plans to extend the date past November 6, 2021. Everyone should see \$25 off their monthly water charges starting in November or December.
