Back Park updates

Front park - a good samaritan provided a new basketball hoop and we called 311 to safely install it.

Back park - We submitted a request for more shade over the play equipment but due to the proximity of trees and playground fall zone, we were not able to add a stand alone shade structure. However, the park district is planning to replace the current swing set with a swing that has a large shade canopy built-in – similar to the photo. It will have the same number and types of swings. PARD will re-use the current swing at another location. The order has just been placed for the swing so the replacement should be within the next 6 to 8 weeks.



Recycle Reuse

A message from our Zero Waste Block Leader...



Hey y'all! Today I want to talk about composting. Austin Resource Recovery (ARR) has had great success incorporating the green bins in many single family homes. They have seen lots of diversion of outdoor plant waste into these containers. Now, Austin is requesting its citizens to start adding more variety into their bins. Specifically, kitchen scraps. Adding kitchen scraps to the compost enriches the soil, reduces the

need for hazardous chemicals, and encourages the breakdown of organic matter into rich nutrient-filled material.

The best way to collect kitchen scraps is in a small compost bin or a similar container. You simply add kitchen scraps and unwanted leftovers to the kitchen compost bin during the week, then take the collected scraps to your outdoor, green bin whenever it is full or before weekly collection. ARR gave me many countertop compost bins to share with the community. If you would like a kitchen bin or if you want to have a discussion about how to use them please contact me. I have included an infographic depicting the types of items that can go in Austin's green bin. One small note: please do not add large volumes of fat to your green bin.

Also in the next few months I will be collecting gently-used school supplies. If you are someone with a child that no longer needs school supplies from this past year please contact me. Also if you are a teacher who is in need of school supplies please contact me. I would like to facilitate an exchange of supplies to better improve teachers' lives and to prevent waste. More information to come in a future newsletter.
