Treasurer's Report for 2022

Main Focus of Funds – continues to be maintenance of our front entrance. So far, this has allowed our neighborhood to prevent curb cuts from present or future adjacent properties.

It also provides an attractive introduction to the neighborhood.

Annual Expenses – Longhorn Lawns (mowing, weeding, trimming, pruning, irrigation monitoring) \$2727.96 (46 memberships)

- - Irrigation system repairs \$1253.66 (20.9 memberships)
- - Front entrance flags \$270.00 (4.5 memberships)
- - Event announcement swooper flags \$101.11 (1.7 memberships)
- - Domain name/registration/renewal \$157.86 (2.6 membership)
- - Mailbox \$168.00 (2.8 memberships)
- - Monument area replacement plants/lighting \$545.30 (9 memberships)
- - Annual meeting/Easter \$1297.05 (21.6 memberships)
- Garage Sale signs \$35.92 (0.6 memberships)
- - July 4 th water slide \$400.00 (6.7 memberships)
- - National Night Out signs \$77.68 (1.3 memberships)
- Halloween block party \$834.45 (13.9 memberships)

Budget Management

- 1. Our annual budget is based on the income from the previous year
- 2. We keep a minimum balance of \$2500.00
- 3. Board members design, print and distribute communications with minimal cost to the NA
- 4. Many expenses have been reduced as a result of board members and their family members donating their time and abilities and, often, their resources to maintain and reach out to our neighborhood and to solicit sponsors to underwrite some of the cost of events.
